

Review of DNS principles. Developmental positions: specific muscle synergies, zones of support, extremity function (support = opened kinematic chain, phasic = closed kinematic chain), anticipatory motion based on the transition, global movement patterns.

DNS assessment and treatment strategies - advanced approach. Postural function as a source of movement system disturbance and pain in general population and athletes. General principles to correct movement patterns to prevent repetitive repetitive strain injury and to improve sport performance. Procedures to train proper alignment of initial joint position and optimal joint position throughout the movement.
